The following conditions are amended as a result of the application made by the operator

Permitted quantities of wastes

- 1.2.2 The quantities of waste accepted shall not exceed those listed in Table 1.1 and Table 1.2A below and or specified in detail in section 1.2 of the working plan. Whilst complying with the maximum quantities specified for each type of waste, the total quantity of waste accepted at the site per year shall not exceed 242,400 tonnes.
