WHEREAS on the 5 August 1993 Wiltshire County Council issued a disposal licence in pursuance of their powers under Part 1 of the Control Of Pollution Act 1974 for the above named facility;

AND WHEREAS on the 1 May 1994 the said licence fell to be treated as a waste management licence;


AND WHEREAS on the 9 September 1994, Wiltshire County Council modified the waste management licence;

AND WHEREAS on the 1st April 1996 the powers and duties of all waste regulation authorities in England and Wales transferred to the Environment Agency by virtue of section 2 of the Environment Act 1995;

AND WHEREAS on 2 January 2001 you applied to modify the conditions of the said licence;

AND WHEREAS the Agency considers a modification of the said licence to be desirable and is unlikely to require an unreasonable expense on the part of the licence holder;

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Agency modifies the conditions of the said licence as shown in Schedule A attached.

SCHEDULE A

MODIFIED LICENCE CONDITIONS

Delete Condition 1 and replace in full with:

1. The types and quantities of wastes received at the facility shall not exceed the operator's ability to deal with them. The total quantity of waste accepted at the site per year shall not exceed 75,000 tonnes.

Amend conditions 3, 4, 7 and 9

Replace "Waste Regulation Officer" with "Environment Agency".

Delete condition 19 and replace in full with:

19. Should the amount, quality and properties of any drainage from the site prove unsatisfactory at any time, provision shall be made for the collection and removal or treatment of the offending liquors. All works undertaken to comply with this condition shall be completed to the satisfaction of the Environment Agency.

Insert condition 20

- 20 No wastes shall be received at the site until an identification board has been provided at or near the site entrance. The identification board shall be inspected at least once per week. In the event of damage or defect, the board shall be repaired or replaced within 3 working days. The board shall be easily readable from outside the site entrance in daylight hours, and shall display the following information:

Site name and address;
Licence Holder name (company name, not individual name unless justified as necessary);
Operator name (company name, not individual name unless justified as necessary);
Licence number;
Emergency contact name and telephone number (for security reasons, personal names and home phone numbers should not be used except where no alternative is practicable);
Statement that the site is licensed by the Environment Agency;
Agency national numbers: 0845 9333111 and 0800 807060;
Days and hours site is open to receive waste.

The location of the notice board should be such that it is clear that it does not designate areas outside the licensed site and does not encourage illegal tipping.

Insert condition 21

- 21 A summary record of the waste types accepted and removed from the site shall be made for each quarter of the financial year, and shall be submitted to the Agency within 1 month following the end of the quarter. The summary record shall be in a format agreed by the Agency in writing.
