The **ENVIRONMENT AGENCY** ("The Agency") in pursuance of its powers under the Water Resources Act 1991 **HEREBY CONSENTS** to the making of a discharge of **SEWAGE EFFLUENT**, as follows:

Treated Sewage Effluent

FROM: A sewage treatment plant serving "Thorney Fold Barn"

AT: Bodle Street Green, near Hailsham, East Sussex

TO: A ditch to an unnamed tributary of the Pevensey Levels

SUBJECT TO the conditions set out in the following schedule:

Treated Sewage Effluent

P.10898/S/02 01

Subject to the provisions of Paragraphs 7 and 8 of Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991 as replaced by Schedule 22 to the Environment Act 1995, no notice shall be served by the Agency, altering this consent without the agreement in writing of the consent holder, during a period of 4 years from the date this consent takes effect or such later date as may be specified in an endorsement to this document.

CONDITIONS OF CONSENT TO DISCHARGE

TREATED SEWAGE EFFLUENT ("the Discharge")

FROM: A SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT SERVING "THORNEY FOLD BARN", BODLE STREET GREEN, NEAR HAILSHAM, EAST SUSSEX

KINNERSLEY RUBRIC (MINIMISE EFFECT)

- 1 (a) The Discharge shall not contain any poisonous, noxious, or polluting matter or solid waste matter.
- (b) Provided that the Discharge hereby consented is made in accordance with the following conditions of this consent, such discharge shall not be taken to be in breach of condition (a) above by reason of containing substances or having properties identified in and controlled by these conditions.

NATURE OF DISCHARGE

- 2 The Discharge shall consist solely of treated sewage effluent.

PLACE OF DISCHARGE

- 3 The Discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as:
 - (a) discharging to a ditch leading to an unnamed tributary of the Pevensey Levels
 - (b) at National Grid Reference TQ 6436 1600
 - (c) shown marked "DISCHARGE POINT" on attached Drawing No. P.10898/S/02 01/D.

SAMPLING POINT REQUIREMENTS

- 4 The consent holder shall provide facilities so as to enable samples of the Discharge to be safely and conveniently obtained at all times.

MAXIMUM DAILY VOLUME

- 5 The volume of the Discharge shall not exceed one cubic metre per day.

COMPOSITION

- 6 The composition of the Discharge shall be such that:
- (a) the biochemical oxygen demand (measured after five days at 20 degrees Celsius with nitrification suppressed by the addition of allyl-thiourea) shall not exceed 25 milligrams per litre.
 - (b) suspended solids, dried at 105 degrees Celsius, shall not exceed 45 milligrams per litre.

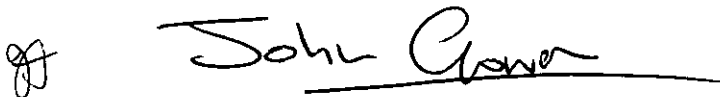
MAINTENANCE

- 7 The sewage treatment plant shall be operated and maintained in accordance with good operational practice such that:
- (a) it remains fully operational except at times of unavoidable mechanical or electrical breakdown which shall be attended to, and the Agency informed of the failure, as soon as practicable after the failure;
 - (b) following a failure all equipment shall be returned to normal operation as soon as practicable;
 - (c) tanks shall be desludged at sufficient frequency and in such a manner to prevent excessive carryover of suspended solids.

NON-INJURIOUS TO FISH

- 8 As far as is reasonably practicable, the sewage treatment plant shall be operated so as to prevent:
- (i) any matter being present in the Discharge, other than matter specifically controlled/limited by condition 6 of this consent, to such an extent as to cause the receiving waters, or any waters of which the receiving waters are a tributary, to be poisonous or injurious to fish in those waters, or to the spawning grounds, spawn or food of fish in those waters, or otherwise cause damage to the ecology of those waters; and
 - (ii) the Discharge from having any other adverse environmental impact.

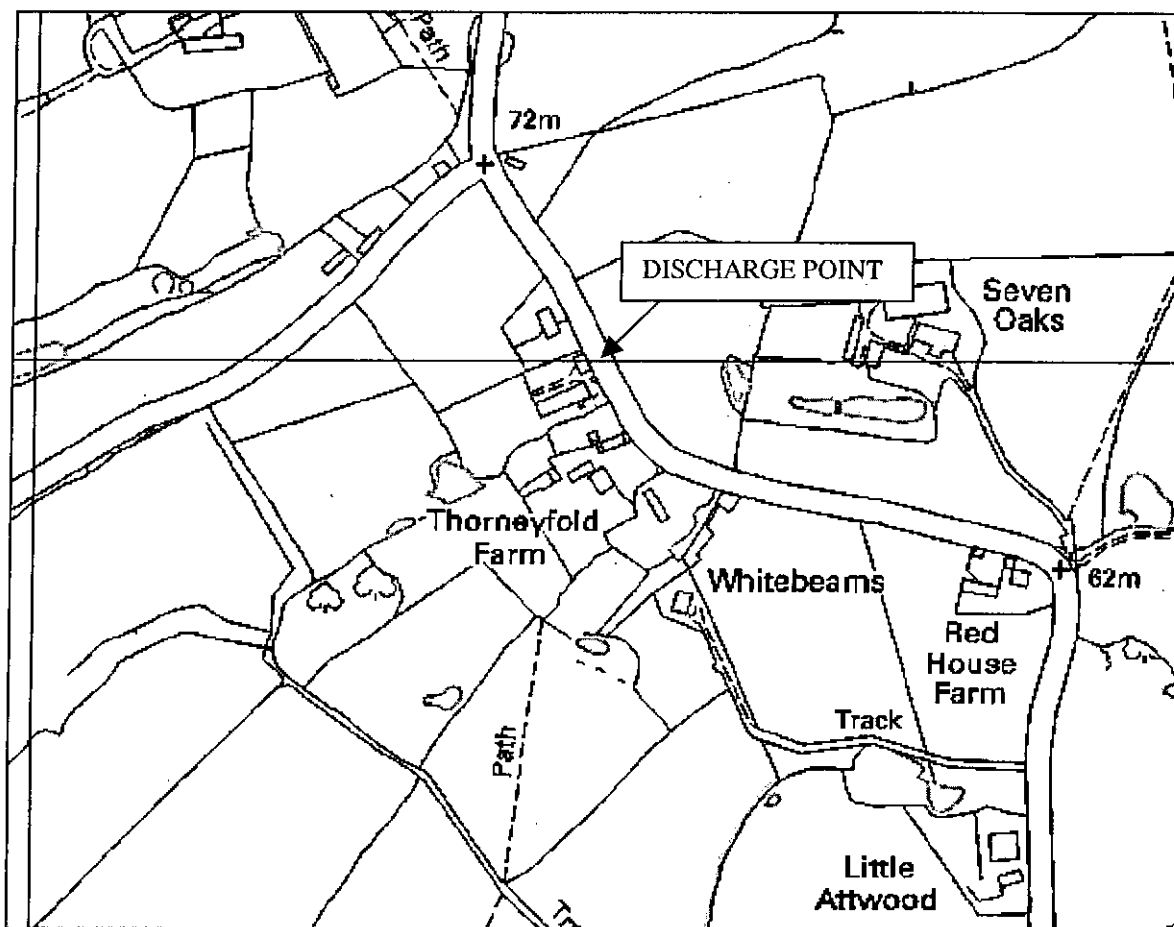
