The specified activity includes 12 main reaction schemes/groups of products as listed in the application. Any proposed new products are subject to a New Product Procedure and Management of Change Procedure, see Table 2.1.1. Also includes the handling, storage and despatch of wastes, principally liquid wastes.

Recovering by distillation of any oil or organic solvent	The washing and distillation of contaminated heat transfer fluids in the same production facility.	Receipt of contaminated fluids and all processing through to despatch of recovered fluids, including handling, storage and despatch of liquid wastes.
Necessary services	Providing necessary services for the specified activities.	Vacuum, compressed air, fire water, cooling water and hot oil systems, the latter fuelled by low sulphur gas oil.
