This modification is made pursuant to the Environmental Protection Act 1990 section 37(1)(a) and (b) and shall take effect at 00.01 hours on 17 April 1996.

The waste management licence dated 8 June 1993 issued to DEBRA AYER trading as TAM HAULAGE & PLANT HIRE, and subsequently transferred to ALL WASTE MOVEMENTS LIMITED, is modified as follows:

Condition 2.1 is deleted and replaced as follows:

- 2.1 The quantity of waste deposited at the facility shall not exceed 460 tonnes on each day from Mondays to Fridays (inclusive) and 184 tonnes on Saturdays.

Conditions 2.2 and 2.3 are deleted.





Condition 2.4.1 is deleted and replaced as follows:

2.4.1 No waste other than controlled wastes as listed below and detailed in Appendix 1, shall be received or handled at the site.

Condition 3.6 is deleted

Conditions 3.6.1 and 3.6.2 are added as follows:

3.6.1 Waste, other than inert waste stored in the area as shown in the working plan, received on any day, shall be removed by the end of the following working day.

3.6.2 Inert waste received on any day shall be removed within the following week.

Condition 4.1 is deleted

Conditions 4.5.1, 4.5.2 and 4.5.3 are deleted and replaced as follows:

4.5.1 Waste shall only be stored in bays in the areas designated in the working plan.

4.5.2 No more than 265 cubic metres of waste shall be stored within the confines of the building as shown in the working plan.

4.5.3 No more than 180 cubic metres of inert waste shall be stored in the designated bay as shown in the working plan.

Conditions 4.5.4 and 4.5.5 are added as follows:

4.5.4 No waste stored within the confines of the building shall be stored to a height exceeding 2.5 metres. No other waste shall be stored to a height exceeding 2.0 metres. Lines shall be marked and maintained on the respective interior facing bay walls to indicate these heights.





- 4.5.5 On at least one occasion during every calendar month the holder shall ensure that the waste storage areas are completely cleared of waste to permit inspection of the condition of the retaining wall, impermeable pavement and drainage system by a duly authorised officer of the Agency. The holder shall notify the Agency three full working days prior to each clearance.

Condition 7.4 is deleted and replaced as follows:

- 7.4 Effective measures shall be taken by the holder to limit the noise and vibration caused by operations at the site.

Condition 9.1 is deleted
