### Introductory note

#### ***This introductory note does not form a part of the permit***

The following notice, which is issued pursuant to regulation 20 and Part 1 of Schedule 5 of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations S.I.2007 No. 3538 (the Regulations), gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit to operate a regulated facility.

The variation notice will incorporate activities originally licensed under the waste licence WML80612 (currently surrendered by the Environment Agency due to the original holder going into administration) into the active EPR permit EPR/MP3834LG. The waste licence covered operations with waste codes D15 and R13 for the storage of hazardous wastes and R4 for the recycling/reclamation of metals and metal compounds.

Schedule 1 of this notice lists any deleted conditions, Schedule 2 lists any added conditions, Schedule 3 lists any conditions that have been amended and Schedule 4 has any changes to the site plan.
