Can you send me the following so I can do Waste Audit Report for wastes coming into and leaving your site.

Three transfer notes for 170904 - mixed construction and demolition wastes other than those mentioned in 17 09 01, 17 09 02 and 17 09 03. As 170904 is mirror non-hazardous waste code can you please provide any waste assessments requested by yourselves from the waste producer to prove the waste is non-hazardous. The producer may not have provided you with any chemical testing but they should have given you a written description of the material and their method for determining that the waste is non-hazardous.

Three transfer notes for the removal of 191212 - other wastes (including mixtures of materials) from mechanical treatment of wastes other than those mentioned in 19 12 11. As this is a mirror non-hazardous waste code can you please provide any waste assessments (chemical testing, sampling plan and interpretation reports) you have to prove this waste is non-hazardous.

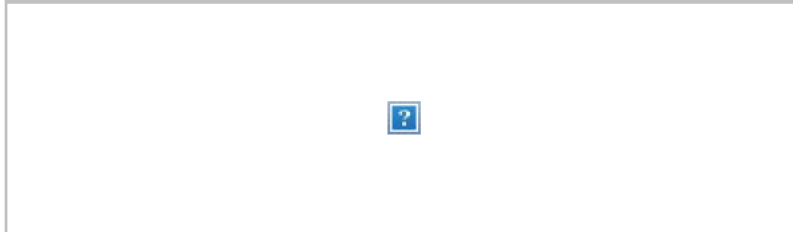
