The Environment Agency ("the Agency") in pursuance of its powers under the Water Resources Act 1991 hereby consents to the making of a discharge of treated sewage effluent, as follows:

Biologically Treated Sewage Effluent (27/20/0056.01)

From: a package treatment plant serving a 2 dwellings

At: White Crag Cottage, Timble, nr. Otley, LS21 2NP

To: an unnamed tributary of the River Washburn

Subject to the conditions set out in this Consent.

Subject to the provisions of Paragraphs 7 and 8 of Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991 (as amended by schedule 22 of the Environment Act 1995), no notice shall be served by the Agency, altering this Consent, without the agreement in writing of the Consent Holder, during a period of 4 years from the date this Consent takes effect.

Conditions of Consent

1 BIOLOGICALLY TREATED SEWAGE EFFLUENT (27/20/0056.01)

Kinnersley Rubric

1.1.1

- a** The Discharge shall not contain any poisonous, noxious or polluting matter or solid waste matter.
- b** Provided that the Discharge hereby consented is made in accordance with the following conditions of this Consent, such discharge shall not be taken to be in breach of condition a above by reason of containing substances or having properties identified in and controlled by these conditions.

Nature

1.1.2

The Discharge shall consist solely of biologically treated sewage effluent arising from two dwellings.

Location

1.1.3

The Discharge shall be made in the manner and at the place specified as:

- a** discharging from a package treatment plant serving two dwellings: White Crag Cottage and the adjoining flat at Timble, nr. Otley, West Yorkshire, LS21 2NP;
- b** discharging via a field drain, to an unnamed tributary of the River Washburn (River Wharfe catchment);
- c** at National Grid Reference SE 1850 5380;
- d** shown marked 'Discharge Point' on the Site Plan attached to this Consent.

Sample point

1.1.4

An appropriately labelled sample point shall be provided and maintained at National Grid Reference SE 1840 5380 as shown marked 'Sample Point' on the Site Plan, so that a representative sample of the Discharge may be obtained.

1.1.5

The Consent Holder shall ensure that all constituents of the Discharge pass through the said sampling point at all times and in any legal proceedings it shall, for the purposes of Section 10 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act 1961, be presumed, until the contrary is shown that any sample of the Discharge taken at the said sampling point is a sample of what was discharging into controlled waters.

Volume

- 1.1.6 The volume of the Discharge shall not exceed 2 cubic metres per day.

Composition

- 1.1.7 The Discharge shall consist only of fully treated sewage effluent which has received treatment via a sewage treatment plant designed and installed to BS 6297 1983 (or its replacement), capable - whilst operating at the full consented flow - of producing an effluent of thirty milligrams per litre (30 mg/l) Suspended Solids and twenty milligrams per litre (20 mg/l) Biochemical Oxygen Demand.

Plant Operation

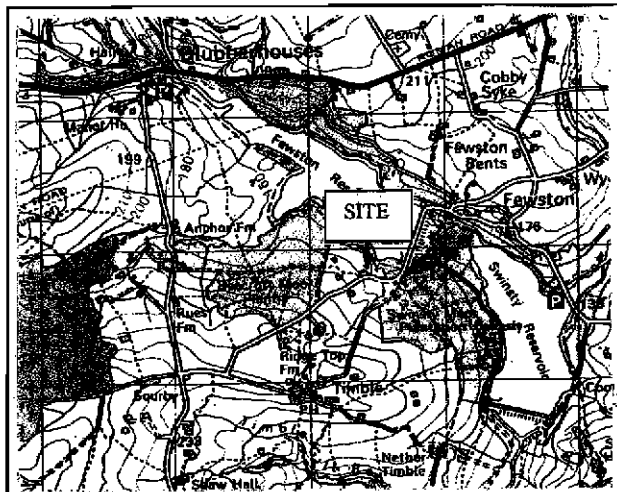
- 1.1.8 As far as is reasonably practicable, the treatment plant shall be operated so as to prevent:
- a any matter being present in the Discharge to such an extent as to cause the receiving waters, or any waters of which the receiving waters are a tributary, to be poisonous or injurious to fish in those waters, or to the spawning grounds, spawn or food of fish in those waters, or otherwise cause damage to the ecology of those waters; and
 - b the Discharge from having any other adverse environmental impact.
- 1.1.9 As far as is reasonably practicable, the treatment plant shall be operated so as to prevent the Discharge from containing any significant trace of visible oil or grease.

Maintenance

- 1.1.10 The treatment plant shall be operated and maintained in accordance with good operational practice such that:
- a it remains fully operational except at times of unavoidable mechanical or electrical breakdown which shall be attended to, as soon as practicable after the failure;
 - b following a failure all equipment shall be returned to normal operation as soon as practicable;
 - c tank(s) shall be desludged at sufficient frequency and in such a manner to prevent excessive carryover of suspended solids.

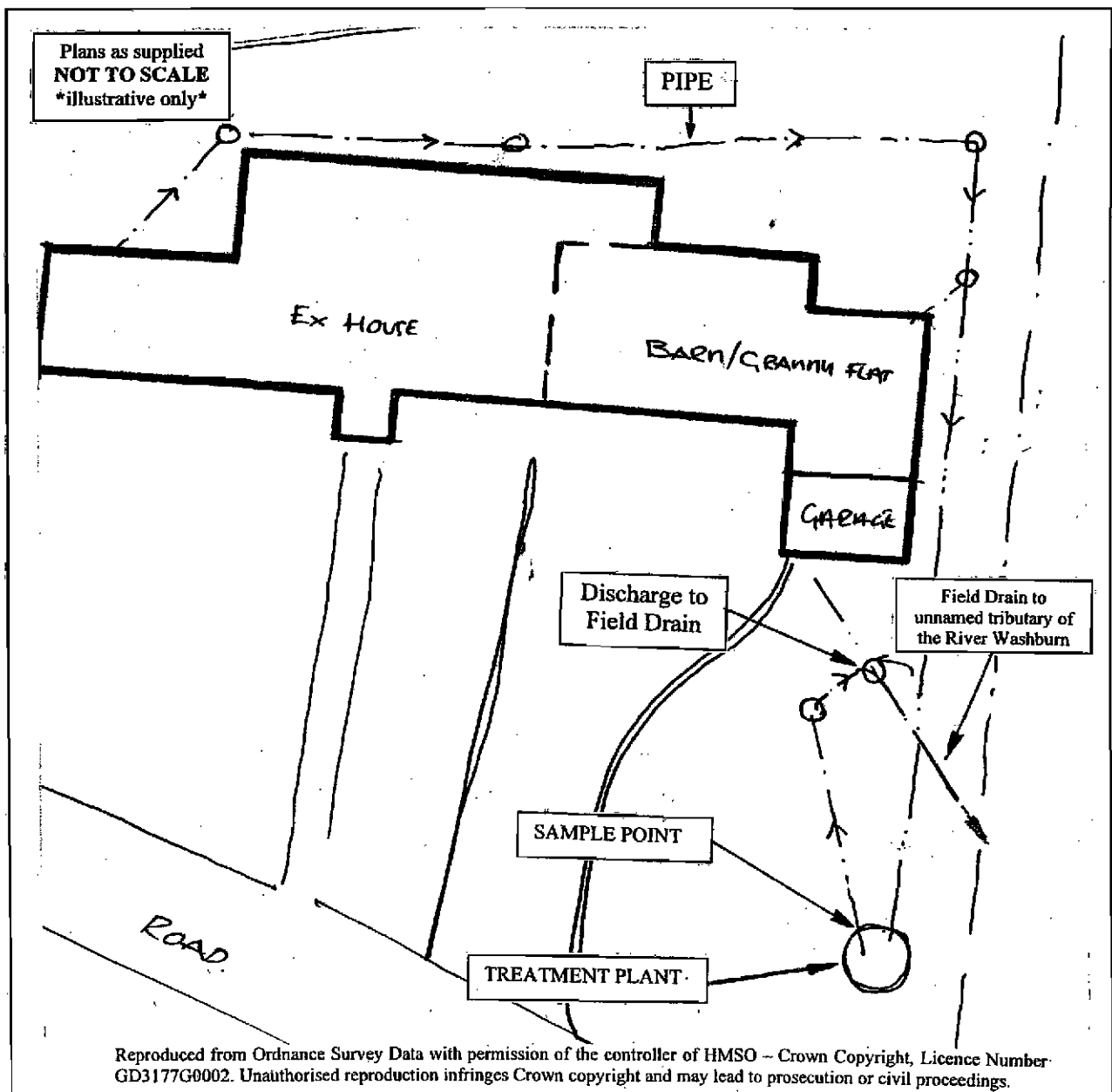
