The conditions to which the aforesaid consent is subject are REPLACED by the following conditions:

1. The discharge shall consist solely of fully treated sewage effluent from an Entec Biotec sewage treatment plant installed, operated and maintained in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions as updated from time to time.
2. The discharge shall be made through an outlet at National Grid Reference SP 8930 8558 into the Harpers Brook.
3. The volume discharged shall not exceed 2.0 cubic metres in any period of 24 hours.
4. The discharge shall at no time contain any matter which will cause the receiving waters to be poisonous or injurious to fish, spawn of fish or food of fish.

5. The discharge shall contain no visible oil or grease.
6. The effluent from the treatment plant shall be discharged to an inspection chamber, fitted with a removable cover, before any surface water connection.
7. The discharge shall be made through an outlet to the watercourse constructed and maintained so that a direct sample of the discharge may be readily obtained.

The period during which no further notice by virtue of paragraph 6(2) or 6(4)(c) of Schedule 10 of the Water Resources Act 1991 shall be served in respect of the consent, without the written agreement of the discharger, shall be the period ending with the last day of February 1994.

NOTICE OF CONSENT



The ANGLIAN WATER AUTHORITY in pursuance of its powers under the above Act HEREBY CONSENTS to the making of a discharge of SEWAGE EFFLUENT and/or SURFACE WATER from premises at No. 14 Little Oakley, Northants into Harpers Brook at National Grid Reference SP 8930 8558 in accordance with the application received on 6 October 1988, subject to the following conditions :-

1. The discharge shall consist of fully treated sewage effluent from an Entec Biotec sewage treatment plant constructed and maintained in accordance with British Standards Institution Code of Practice Bs 6297:1983 and/or surface water.
2. The volume discharged under dry weather conditions shall not exceed two cubic metres in any period of 24 hours.
3. The effluent from the treatment plant shall be discharged to an inspection chamber, fitted with a removable cover, before any surface water connection.
4. The discharge shall be made through an outlet to the watercourse constructed and maintained so that a direct sample of the discharge may be readily obtained.

This consent will not be revoked nor will the conditions thereof be modified without the written agreement of the person making the discharge before the expiration of the period ending with the last day of November 1990.

COPA REGISTER DATE ENTRY FIRST MADE 5 NOV 1988
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NOTE

1. If you consider that any of the conditions subject to which this consent is granted, or that the period specified in the final paragraph of this consent, is unreasonable, you may, by virtue of Section 39 (1) of the Act, appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment.
2. The procedure for appealing is governed by the Control of Pollution (Consents for Discharges) (Secretary of State Functions) Regulations 1984 (1984 S. I. No 865), to which anyone wishing to appeal should refer. Notice of appeal, together with a statement of the grounds of appeal, must be given in writing to the Secretary of State within three months of notification of the Authority's decision.
3. Any contravention of the conditions subject to which this consent is granted is an offence under the Act and will render the discharger liable to prosecution by the Authority and by any other person.
4. This consent is in respect of water quality considerations only and should not be interpreted as being applicable to land drainage requirements. A consent under the Land Drainage Byelaws may also be required.
5. The granting of S.34 Consent under the Control of Pollution Act does not give any right or permission to discharge to a watercourse where land is not owned by the holder of the Consent.
