Lincolnshire County Council as Waste Disposal Authority hereby give notice that under the provisions of Section 7 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974 the disposal licence is now modified as follows:-

Delete Condition 5

Append to Condition 2 - Water based bentonite drilling mud 6 tonnes

Insert Conditions:

- 5 No liquids or sludges shall be brought to the site unless specified elsewhere in the conditions attached to the licence
- 33 Water based drilling mud shall only be deposited if
- a) written details of the chemical constitution of the mud from each source has been provided to the County Waste Regulation Officer
 - b) the County Waste Regulation Officer raises no objection to the deposit of the mud
 - c) a purpose built lagoon has been provided and the mud is deposited directly into and is completely retained within it.

Appeals must be notified within six months of the date of this licence by means of the procedure specified in The Collection and Disposal of Waste Regulations 1988 and addressed to the Secretary of State, Department of the Environment (NNW2), Room A2.22, Romney House, 43 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY. The Secretary of State has power to allow a longer period for the giving of notice of an appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of an appeal.
