This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

This variation, at the request of the operator is to increase the annual tonnage from 300,000 tonnes to 600,000 tonnes and increase the tonnage allowed on site at any one time. It also adds one waste code to the permitted wastes. There is no change to the activities on site. The site remains a non-hazardous waste transfer station. No hazardous waste is permitted.

The following condition has been amended as a result of the application made by the operator:

2.1 Permitted activities

2.1.1 The operator is only authorised to carry out the activities specified in schedule 1 table S1.1 (the “activities”)

Description of activities for waste operations	Limits of activities
R13: Storage of waste pending any of the operations numbered R1 to R12 (excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where the waste is produced)	No more than 12,000 tonnes of waste is stored on site at any one time. Waste types as specified in Table S2.1

2.3 Operating techniques

2.3.1 The activities shall, subject to the conditions of this permit be operated using the techniques and in the manner described in the documentation specified in schedule 1, table S1.2, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Environment Agency.

2.3.2 If notified by the Environment Agency that the activities are giving rise to pollution, the operator shall submit to the Environment Agency for approval within the period specified, a revision of any plan or other documentation (“plan”) specified in schedule 1, table S1.2 or otherwise required under this permit which identifies and minimises the risks of pollution relevant to that plan, and shall implement the approved revised plan in place of the original from the date of approval, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Environment Agency.

2.3.3 Waste shall only be accepted if:

- (a) it is of a type and quantity listed in schedule 2 table S2.1 and
- (b) it conforms to the description in the documentation supplied by the producer and holder.
