RIGHTS OF APPEAL UNDER SECTION 43 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990

If the licence holder is aggrieved by the decision of the Environment Agency in modifying the conditions of a Waste Management Licence, he may appeal to the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 43 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, Section 114 of the Environment Act 1995 and Regulations 6 and 7 of the Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994. Appeals must be notified within six months of the date of this Notice to the Secretary, c/o The Planning Inspectorate, Room 10/13, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DN. The Secretary of State has the power to allow a longer period for the giving of notice of an appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of an appeal.

(1) Category A Solid Waste 200 Tonnes

ADD : to Condition 101 new sub-paragraph (5)

(5) The quantities of waste received at the site shall not exceed 74,999 tonnes in any financial year. 'Financial year' means the twelve months ending 31 March.
