Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the permit

The following notice is issued under regulation 17 of The Pollution Prevention and Control (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 (S.I.2000 No. 1973 (as amended) (the Regulations) to vary the conditions of a permit issued under the Regulations to operate an installation. The notice comprises schedule A containing conditions to be deleted, schedule B conditions to be amended and schedule C conditions to be added.

The main features of the installation and the variation are as follows.

A PPC permit was issued to Collier Industrial Waste Ltd on 6 October 2006 for the storage and treatment of hazardous and non-hazardous wastes. This included the mixing of shredded refuse with sludges before disposal to landfill. The purpose is to condition the sludges to increase its bulk density and reduce the number of vehicle movements and to improve its handling at the landfill by reducing dust, litter, and attractiveness to vermin.

To date this mixing has taken place in open pits. The permit contained an improvement condition requiring treatment operations in the sludge pits to cease by 10 November 2008. The variation application received on 23 October 2008 was to relocate the conditioning process from the pits to an above ground process located in a building and to continue to store the conditioned waste in one of the pits; SP0.

The Agency has determined to grant the application, subject to conditions.

The Agency has determined that the proposal does not fully meet the requirement to achieve BAT with regard to the continued storage and loading from an open pit. An improvement condition has been included which requires the necessary changes to this activity to be made by June 2009.

The Agency has also determined that the method of storing and handing of the sludge inputs does not fully meet the requirement to achieve BAT. An improvement condition has been included which requires the necessary changes to this activity to be made by June 2009.

For the benefit of clarity these changes have been issued as consolidated conditions.
