CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO CONSENT NOTICE

1. The effluent discharged to the stream shall consist only of site drainage and steam condensate from the curing chambers and shall not:-

- (a) contain Suspended Solids, dried at 105°C, in excess of 75 milligrams per litre,
- (b) contain mineral oils and hydrocarbons in excess of 5 milligrams per litre,
- (c) have a pH value less than 3 nor greater than 11.

2. The volume of effluent discharged to the stream shall not exceed 1300 litres per day under dry weather conditions.

The terms of this Notice will not, without the consent in writing of the person to whom this Notice is given (or his successor), be altered before the expiration of the period ending with the twenty second day of May 1983.
