Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of an Environment Agency initiated variation an environmental permit.

Firstly, this variation adds the standard modern condition 1.1.1 requiring the operator to manage and operate their activities in accordance with a written management system.

Secondly, as this permit authorises the storage of combustible waste, we have varied it to include a standard condition that requires operators to take all appropriate measures to prevent fires on site and minimise the risk of pollution from them and, if required by us, to submit for approval a fire prevention plan that once approved must be implemented.

The changes made to the original permit as a result of the Environment Agency initiated variation are set out in schedule 3.

The following conditions are added following an Environment Agency initiated variation

1.1 SPECIFIED WASTE MANAGEMENT OPERATIONS

1. The operator shall manage and operate the activities:
 - (a) in accordance with a written management system that identifies and minimises risks of pollution, including those arising from operations, maintenance, accidents, incidents, non-conformances, closure and those drawn to the attention of the operator as a result of complaints; and
 - (b) using sufficient competent persons and resources.
2. No waste management operations shall be authorised by this licence unless specified in and undertaken in accordance with the limitations in the following table:

		<u>Brewery hops</u>; 96 hours (notwithstanding the requirements for odour control). <u>All other permitted wastes</u>; no restriction. <u>At least once every 28 days</u> all waste storage bay(s) shall be cleared of sufficient wastes to permit inspection and maintenance by the licence holder. Permitted location of operation: <u>Degradable wastes and brewers hops</u>; within walled storage bays and on impermeable pavement draining to sealed tank as detailed by sections EA/NG/AR2-A & C of the working plan and in accordance with condition 2.2. <u>Shredded and unshredded wood (segregated for reuse)</u>; on impermeable pavement draining to soakaway as detailed by sections EA/NG/AR5-A & B of the working plan and in accordance with condition 2.2. <u>All other permitted wastes</u>; at the locations and within sealed containers as detailed by sections EA/NG/AR2-C, D & E, EA/NG/AR3-C & D and EA/NG/AR5-C, D & F of the working plan and in accordance with condition 2.2.

3. In accordance with section EA/NG/OV-L of the working plan waste disposal shall not continue at the site.

4.3 FIRES ON THE SITE

3. The operator shall take all appropriate measures to prevent fires on site and minimise the risk of pollution from them including, but not limited to, those specified in any approved fire prevention plan.
4. The operator shall:
 - (a) if notified by the Environment Agency that the activities are giving rise to a risk of fire, submit to the Environment Agency for approval within the period specified, a fire prevention plan which prevents fires and minimises the risk of pollution from fires;
 - (b) implement the fire prevention plan, from the date of approval, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Environment Agency.
