The following condition shall be amended to.

Condition 3 Any other wastes deemed suitable for disposal at this facility shall require notification and agreement from the Agency in writing prior to acceptance.

Wastes subject to the Special Waste Regulations 1996 or any subsequent amending legislation shall not be accepted.

## RIGHTS OF APPEAL

Section 43(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 provides that:

Where, except in pursuance of a direction given by the Secretary of state ,

- (a) an application for a modification of the conditions to the licence is rejected
- (b) the conditions to a licence are modified

the applicant may appeal from the decision to the Secretary of State.

Therefore if you are aggrieved by the decision detailed on the attached notice you may obtain the appropriate form on which to give written notice of an appeal from:-

This notice of appeal should be accompanied by the following information: a copy of the licence; a copy of any correspondence relevant to the appeal; a copy of any other document relevant to the appeal including, in particular, any relevant consent, determination, notice, planning permission, established use certificate or certificate of lawful use or development : and a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or on the basis of written representations. You are also required to serve a copy of your notice of appeal, together with copies of any the above documents that have accompanied your notice of appeal, on the Environment Agency (at the address overleaf). You should appeal within 6 months of the date that this notice takes effect but the Secretary of State may allow notice of appeal to be given after the expiry of this time period.

You should note that whilst an appeal is pending the decision detailed on the attached notice is ineffective, except where a statement is included saying that the opinion of the agency the details on the notice are necessary for the purposes of preventing, or where not practicable, minimising pollution of the environment, or harm to human health.

## 2.1 Materials

Personal protective clothing (gloves, masks, overalls, boots, etc. are available for use. Drizit or similar proprietary absorbent materials in loose, pad or pillow form are stored at the site. Shovels, brooms, buckets, hoses, etc. are in daily use.

## 2.2 Action by Employees

Tanker Waste Technicians are expected to tackle minor events independently and to use their discretion to advise the Operations Manager at Avonmouth of the need for further resources.

Tanker discharging will be suspended as soon as an incident is identified and existing tankers on site will be moved to a safe position if possible. Incoming tankers will be redirected away from the discharge point in order not to restrict emergency access or egress. The Operations Manager is to be notified as soon as possible and the event logged in the site diary.
