THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY HEREBY GIVES NOTICE modifying the said conditions as shown below;

DELETE: from Condition 1.1 the words "J10 Asbestos in the cement or other hard sealed forms only" and "M50 Oil/water (10%)."

RIGHTS OF APPEAL UNDER SECTION 43 OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990

If the licence holder is aggrieved by the decision of the Environment Agency in modifying the conditions of a Waste Management Licence, he may appeal to the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 43 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 and Regulation 6 of the Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994. Appeals must be notified within six months of the date of this Notice to the Secretary, c/o The Planning Inspectorate, Room 10/13, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DN. The Secretary of State has the power to allow a longer period for the giving of notice of an appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of an appeal.
