Table 2.1 Licensed activities	
Description of activities	Limits of activities
R13: Storage of waste pending any of the operations listed in paragraphs 1 to 12 of Part IV of Schedule 4 of the Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994, but excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where it is produced.	All bulking or transfer of non-hazardous waste must be carried out inside a building. Non-hazardous wastes must be kept in a building or within a secure container. Non-hazardous waste must be kept on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage.
R3: Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents, including composting and other biological transformation processes. R4: Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds. R5: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.	Treatment consisting only of manual sorting, mechanical sorting or separation (using trommels, screeners, eddy current separators, magnets and optical sorting) pulverising, crushing, baling, compaction and densification of non-hazardous or inert waste. Treatment of non-hazardous waste must be carried out within a building and on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage.

3 – Emissions and Monitoring

3.8 Fire Prevention

3.8.1 The operator shall take all appropriate measures to prevent fires on site and minimise the risk of pollution from them including, but not limited to, those specified in any approved fire prevention plan.

3.8.2 The operator shall:

- (a) if notified by the Environment Agency that the activities are giving rise to a risk of fire, submit to the Environment Agency for approval within the period specified, a fire prevention plan which prevents fires and minimises the risk of pollution from fires;
- (b) implement the fire prevention plan, from the date of approval, unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Environment Agency.
