The THAMES WATER AUTHORITY ("the Authority") pursuant to Section 34 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974 HEREBY CONSENT to the making of the discharge described in the First Schedule overleaf in accordance with your application dated 27 June 1988 and the plan accompanying the same SUBJECT to the conditions set out in the Second Schedule overleaf.

The terms of this consent will not, without the agreement in writing of the person to whom this consent is given (or his successor) be altered before the expiration of the period of 24 months from the date of this Consent except in accordance with the provisions of Section 38(3) of the Control of Pollution Act 1974.

FIRST SCHEDULE

Description of Discharge

The making of a discharge of trade effluent from Old Bibury Trout Farm, Bibury, Cirencester, Gloucestershire to the River Coln.

SECOND SCHEDULE

Conditions

1. The discharge shall be made at National Grid Reference SP 114 068 at the point indicated on the submitted plan.
 2. The discharge shall be made by means of one or more pipe outlets.
 3. The discharge shall consist only of fish farm effluent.
 4. The discharge shall not contain any matter which will cause or be likely to cause the water in the River Coln to be poisonous or injurious to fish or the spawning grounds, spawn or food of fish.
 5. The discharge shall not contain more than 20 mg/l of oil or grease and in any event shall not cause any visible trace of oil or grease to appear on the surface of the River Coln.
 6. The volume of the discharge shall not exceed 120,000 cubic metres per day.
 7. The discharge shall conform to the following standard:
 - (a) Suspended solids content (dried at 105 degrees Celsius) shall not exceed that of the intake water by more than 4 milligrammes per litre.
 - (b) BOD (ATU) in 5 days at 20 degrees Celsius shall not exceed that of the intake water by more than 2 milligrammes per litre.
 - (c) Ammoniacal nitrogen content shall not exceed that of the intake water by more than 0.5 milligrammes per litre.
 - (d) Un-ionised ammoniacal nitrogen content shall not exceed 0.021 milligrammes per litre or that of the intake water whichever shall be the greater.
 - (e) Dissolved oxygen content shall not be less than 70% air saturation or that of the intake water whichever shall be the lesser.
- For the purpose of this condition the intake water shall mean a sample of the River Coln taken at the point shown on the attached plan not more than 60 minutes before the taking of the sample of the discharge.
8. The discharge shall not contain any prophylactic or medicinal substances other than those previously agreed with the Authority.
 9. Facilities to enable the Authority's Officers to take samples of the discharge and abstraction shall be provided and maintained at the points shown on the attached plan.
 10. All conditions hereinbefore imposed shall take effect from the 1 January 1990.
