NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE

WHEREAS on 28 July 1993 Northumberland County Council granted to you a Waste Disposal Licence (now to be treated as a Waste Management Licence) reference NBL/135 relating to Sisters Waste Disposal Site, near Widdrington, Northumberland subject to the conditions set out therein

NOTICE is HEREBY GIVEN that the Environment Agency ("the Agency") modifies the said conditions as follows:-

Licence Conditions B.2 and F.1 shall be deleted, and the following Licence Conditions B.2 and F.1 shall be substituted.

B.2 No special waste as defined by Regulations in force under Section 62 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 shall be accepted at the site.

F.1 A record shall be kept of all wastes received and of all materials (wastes and recovered materials) removed from the site. The records shall include the following for each vehicle load of waste/material:

- (a) origin of waste, by local authority district
- (b) time and date received
- (c) quantities in tonnes received and waste type - as specified by the Agency
- (d) time and date removed
- (e) quantities in tonnes removed and waste type - as specified by the Agency
- (f) destination of materials removed, by local authority district

A summary of the information, including nil returns, shall be submitted to the Agency, in a format and frequency as required by the Agency.

The summary shall be submitted within fourteen days of the end of the accounting period specified by the Agency.

A summary of the consumption of air space and confirmation of the remaining capacity at the site shall be submitted to the Agency, in a format agreed with the Agency, for the twelve months proceeding 1 April each year before 30 April of that year.

Such modification shall take effect on 1 September 1997 at 8am.
