Notice of Modification of Waste Management Licence Conditions

WHEREAS the Northumberland County Council on 1 May 1994 granted you Waste Management Licence Number NBL/135 relating to

Sisters Waste Disposal Site
near Widdrington

subject to the conditions set out therein

NOTICE is HEREBY GIVEN that Northumberland County Council modifies the said conditions as follows:-

Add the following licence conditions :-

- C.18 On completion of disposal operations in an area a capping layer shall be emplaced over the deposited waste materials. The capping layer shall consist of either :-
- (a) a minimum thickness of one metre of natural material such that the maximum permeability is 1.0×10^{-9} metre/second, or;
 - (b) synthetic materials with an equivalent maximum permeability.
- No work shall commence on the installation of the capping layer until all the details of the proposed design, method of installation and the quality control and assurance procedures have been approved in writing by the Council.
- C.19 Leachate shall not be recirculated or spray irrigated onto restored areas of the site without the written permission of the Council.
- C.20 No waste shall be deposited after 1 April 1996 unless a weighbridge is installed at a suitable position and maintained in a serviceable condition. All vehicles depositing waste at the site shall use the weighbridge.

Such modification shall take effect on 17 November 1995 at 8 am.
