Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the notice

The following notice gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit.

This variation increases the permitted area, increases the total annual throughput from 120,000 tonnes per year to 250,000 tonnes per year, increases the total volume on site at any one time from 3,000 tonnes to 25,000 tonnes, and adds a new non-hazardous waste 17 03 02 bituminous mixtures.

The schedules specify the changes made to the original permit.

We consider that in reaching our decision to vary the permit we have taken into account all relevant considerations and legal requirements and that the permit will ensure at least an equivalent level of protection to human health and the quality of the environment.

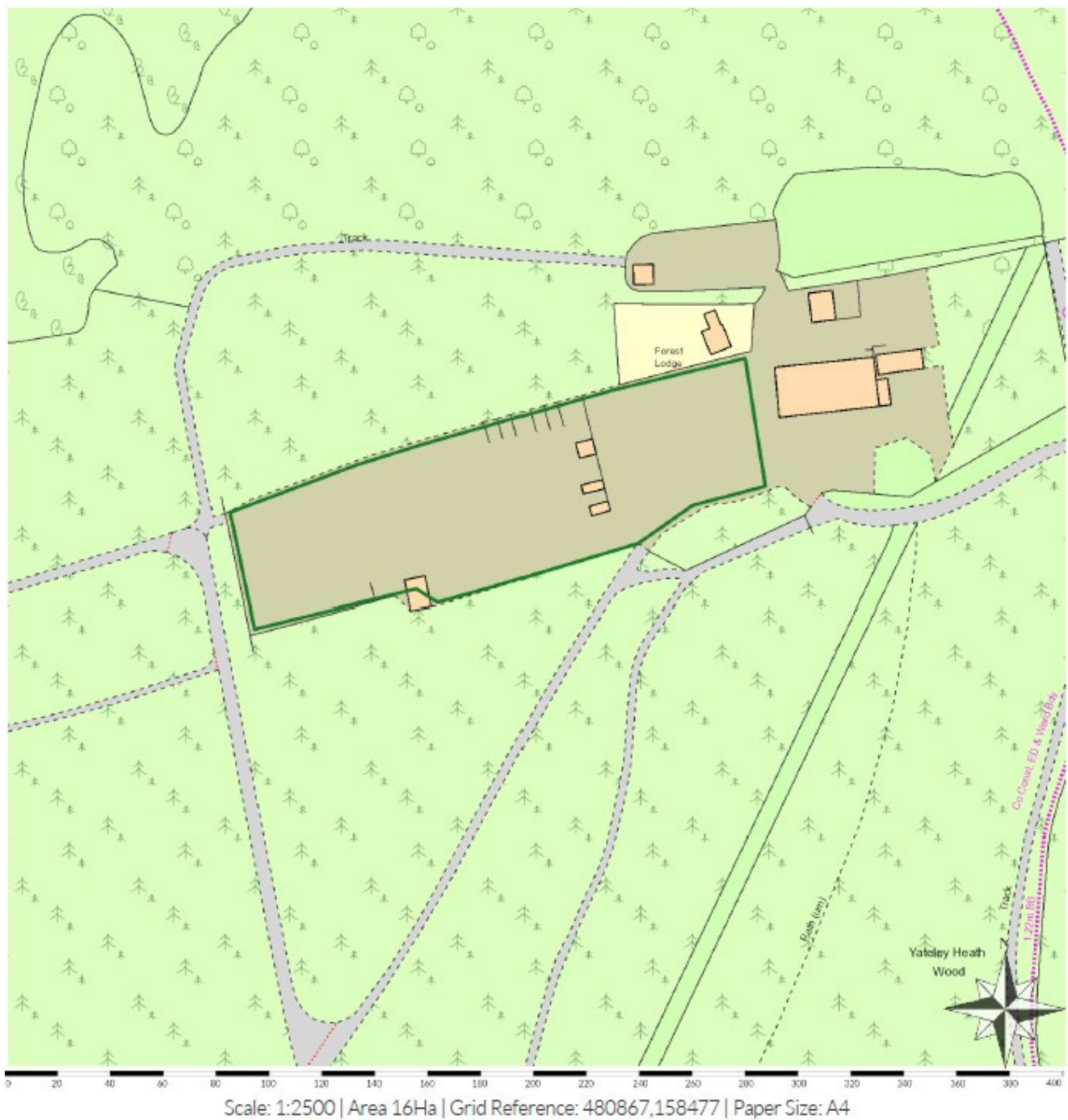
