

WASTE CATEGORY A:

AUTHORISED

Naturally occurring and manufactured material for which the environmental impact of deposition is less than or comparable with that of topsoil. It does not contain substances other than those types included in the list below:

Soil
Rock
Stone
Clay
Sand
Brick Bats
Slates
Uncoated clay-based tiles

WASTE CATEGORY B:

AUTHORISED

Material only slightly soluble in water but because of its origin may be contaminated with material of low polluting potential. It does not contain substances other than those types included in the list below:

Brickwork and concrete (hardcore)
Weathered/excavated coated roadstone (tarmac and bitumac)
Weathered/excavated cement and cement products
Glass, pottery, ceramics, china, enamels (baked and finished products) and mica
Silica

EXCLUSIONS

Waste included in Categories A and B are not permitted if they:

- a) are mixed with or contaminated with any materials other than those listed in Category A or B above or substances that would render them special wastes under The Special Waste Regulations 1996.
- b) are in a sludge or liquid form (not self supporting)
- c) are in a dust, ash, powdered or particulate form and are not double bagged in polythene or other suitable handling means as agreed by the Environment Agency prior to the acceptance of the material.

Conditions: 1 - 7

1. Type of Waste

The type of waste deposited at the site shall be limited to the following:-

- (a) Excavated material such as chalk, clay, soil.
- (b) Non-hazardous construction and demolition waste and skip hire waste containing no more than 20% paper, cardboard, metal (such as galvanised iron, paint tins), wood, plastic, cloth.

The following waste shall not be deposited at the site:-

- Industrial waste (with the exception of the above).
- Putrescible (rotting) waste or obnoxious material.
- Waste oil, solvents or chemicals.
- Waste controlled by regulations made under Section 17 of the Control of Pollution Act 1974.

Other waste not specified above may only be accepted with the prior written consent of the Waste Disposal Authority. Any unpermitted waste brought to the site shall be removed immediately.

2. The site shall be fenced and gated to the satisfaction of the Waste Disposal Authority.
3. Waste shall be compacted and formed into a layer as soon as possible after deposit and within such time necessary to keep the amount of material not formed into a layer at a level acceptable to the Waste Disposal Authority.
4. Waste with the exception of clean hardcore and soil shall be progressively covered with soil or similar material so that by the end of the working day the waste is covered to a depth of not less than 15 centimetres.
5. All site roads shall be maintained to the satisfaction of the Waste Disposal Authority and to a degree sufficient to permit vehicles to get to and from the working face in all weathers, without having to travel excessive distances over untreated surfaces.
6. The depth of a layer of waste shall not after initial compaction exceed 2.5 metres.
7. All large articles such as furniture, crates and hollow containers likely to cause voids shall be crushed, broken up or flattened and covered each day by other wastes in such a position that they are not within one metre of the surface or two metres of the flanks or face.

8. Not less frequently than once a week any loose waste which may be lying on the site shall be gathered and disposed of in such a way as to keep the site tidy.
9. No waste material shall be burnt within the boundaries of the site, and a fire at the site shall be regarded as an emergency and immediate action shall be taken to extinguish it. All outbreaks of fire shall be notified forthwith to the Waste Disposal Authority.
10. Precautions shall be taken to deal effectively with any vermin and insects on the site.
11. The terms of the site licence and any subsequent amendments shall be made known to any person who is given responsibility for the management or control of the site and a copy of this shall be displayed at the location specified by the Waste Disposal Authority.
12. Each layer of waste and covering material shall be laid to a fall to encourage surface water run-off and graded to prevent ponding.
13. A record shall be kept of the type and quantities of waste deposited on the site. Such a record shall be in a form approved by the Waste Disposal Authority. A summary of the records shall be submitted on a form provided by the Authority at specified periods.
