CONSENT TO PRE-1951 DISCHARGE OF TRADE OR SEWAGE EFFLUENT

WHEREAS the Mersey and Weaver River Authority (hereinafter called 'the Authority') have received an application from **Dutton's Blackburn Brewery Limited, High Street, Blackburn in the County of Lancaster.**

(hereinafter called 'the Applicant') for the consent of the Authority under Section 1 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act, 1961, to make a discharge of ~~sewage~~ [sewage] effluent from the septic tank and filter installation serving the Applicant's King William IV Hotel, Dimple, near Bolton in the County of Lancaster at the point (National Grid Ref. SD 70481567) shown on the drawing enclosed with the applications dated 31st May, 1963 to a stream within the area of the Authority, namely
an unnamed tributary of Delph Brook

being a discharge which is not controlled under Section 7 of the Rivers (Prevention of Pollution) Act, 1951.

NOW THE AUTHORITY HEREBY GRANT TO THE APPLICANT THEIR CONSENT

to make the said discharge subject to the following conditions:-

1. the nature shall be that of purified domestic sewage effluent.
2. the volume shall be limited to that of the domestic sewage from the said property with all roof and surface water excluded.
3. the composition shall be in accordance with the under-mentioned standards, i.e.:-
 - (a) the biochemical oxygen demand (5 days at 20°C) shall not exceed 20 milligrammes per litre.
 - (b) the content of suspended solids (dried at 105°C) shall not exceed 30 milligrammes per litre.
4. suitable sampling facilities shall be provided to enable duly authorised officers of the Authority to take samples of the said discharge at a point prior to the admixture of any roof or surface water.
