Description of activities for waste operations	Limits of activities
R13: Storage of waste pending any of the operations listed in paragraphs 1 to 12 of Part IV of Schedule 4 of the Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994, but excluding temporary storage, pending collection, on the site where it is produced.	Non-hazardous wastes must be kept in a building or within a secure container. Non-hazardous waste must be kept on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage.
R3: Recycling or reclamation of organic substances which are not used as solvents, including composting and other biological transformation processes. R4: Recycling or reclamation of metals and metal compounds. R5: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials. R5: Recycling or reclamation of other inorganic materials.	Treatment consisting only of manual sorting, mechanical sorting or separation (using trommels, screeners, eddy current separators, magnets and optical sorting) pulverising, crushing, baling, compaction and densification of non-hazardous or inert waste. Treatment of non-hazardous waste must be carried out within a building and on an impermeable surface with sealed drainage.
