Introductory note

This introductory note does not form a part of the permit

The following notice is issued under regulation 17 of The Pollution Prevention and Control (England and Wales) Regulations 2000 (S.I.2000 No. 1973 (as amended) (the Regulations) to vary the conditions of a permit issued under the Regulations to operate an installation. The notice comprises schedule A containing conditions to be deleted, schedule B conditions to be amended and schedule C conditions to be added.

The main features of the installation and the variation are as follows.

A PPC permit was issued to Collier Industrial Waste Ltd on 6 October 2006 for the storage and treatment of hazardous and non-hazardous wastes before disposal through acid/alkali neutralisation, physico-chemical precipitation/fixation, settlement, and oil/sludge separation. These activities take place in large open-topped liquid waste treatment and sludge pits. Activities also include the dewatering of sludge and waste shredding. Recovered materials are sent off site for recovery. The site has a trade effluent consent allowing discharges to sewer. The majority of the treated wastes are presently sent to landfill.

The permit contained a number of improvement conditions relating to environmental improvements and plant upgrades. The variation application received on 3 April 2008 was to extend the deadline in IP 5 and IP 6 to upgrade the sludge processing pits, the liquid waste treatment pits, the wedge wire screens and the tanker wash pit from 30 June 2008 to 30 June 2009.

The Agency has determined to partially grant the application.

For the sludge processing (mixing) pits the Agency has determined to implement the national date for closure of mixing pit operations of 10 November 2008, and refuse an extension beyond this date. IP 5 and IP 6 have been varied to reflect this.

The Agency has determined to grant a similar extension until 10 November 2008 to the deadline to cease the treatment of hazardous waste in the liquid waste treatment pits and wedge wire screens. The permitted activities and waste types have been amended and a new improvement condition IP 9 added to reflect this. Table S1.2 has been amended to reflect improvements proposed by the operator in the information supplied in response to the schedule 7 notice requesting further information.

The Agency has determined to grant a longer 12 month extension for the treatment of non hazardous waste and to the beneficial disposal of suitable hazardous waste used as a reagent in the waste treatment process. However this has been made conditional on compliance with outstanding relevant improvement conditions. New improvement conditions (IP10 IP11 and IP12) have been added to reflect these changes for the liquid waste treatment pits, the wedge wire screens and the tanker wash pit.

For the benefit of clarity these changes have been issued as consolidated conditions.
