CONSENT CONDITIONS

- 1.(i) The discharge shall not contain any poisonous, noxious, or polluting matter or solid waste matter.
- (ii) Provided that the discharge hereby consented is made in accordance with the following conditions of this consent, such discharge shall not be taken to be in breach of condition 1.(i) above by reason of containing substances or having properties identified in and controlled by those conditions.
2. Outlet A shall be used for the discharge of biologically treated domestic sewage effluent.

CONSENT CONDITIONS CONTINUED

3. The volume of the discharge from 'Tidworth Garrison STW' under dry weather flow conditions shall not exceed 1760.0 cubic metres per day. The rate of discharge shall not exceed 55.0 litres per second.

For the purpose of this consent dry weather flow shall mean the average daily flow to the treatment works during seven consecutive days without rain (excluding a period of which includes public holidays) following seven days during which the rainfall did not exceed 0.25 millimetres on one day.

4. The soakaway lagoon shall be located in accordance with the attached plan.
5. The soakaway lagoon shall have no direct connection with a watercourse, ditch, surface water drain, land drain or water contained in underground strata.
6. At the written request of the Authority the discharger shall install and maintain flow measuring and recording devices to the Authority's specification to measure total daily flow and rate of flow. The installation shall be located, designed, constructed, maintained and calibrated to the satisfaction of the Authority. The discharger shall make returns of the information to the Authority as required. Flow measuring devices shall be accessible at all times without delay to the Authority's representatives.
7. The treated effluent will be sampled at the point labelled 1 on the attached plan which is a chamber prior to the outlet to the soakaway lagoon.
8. The sampling chamber shall be maintained in a satisfactory and safe condition and shall be accessible at all times to the Authority's officers for the purpose of taking samples and ensuring satisfactory operation.
9. The discharge of treated effluent shall not:-
 - (a) have a biochemical oxygen demand (nitrification suppressed, over 5 days at 20 degrees C) in excess of 30 mg/l.
 - (b) contain suspended solids (dried at 105 degrees C) in excess of 40 mg/l.
 - (c) have an ammoniacal nitrogen concentration (as N) in excess of 20 mg/l.

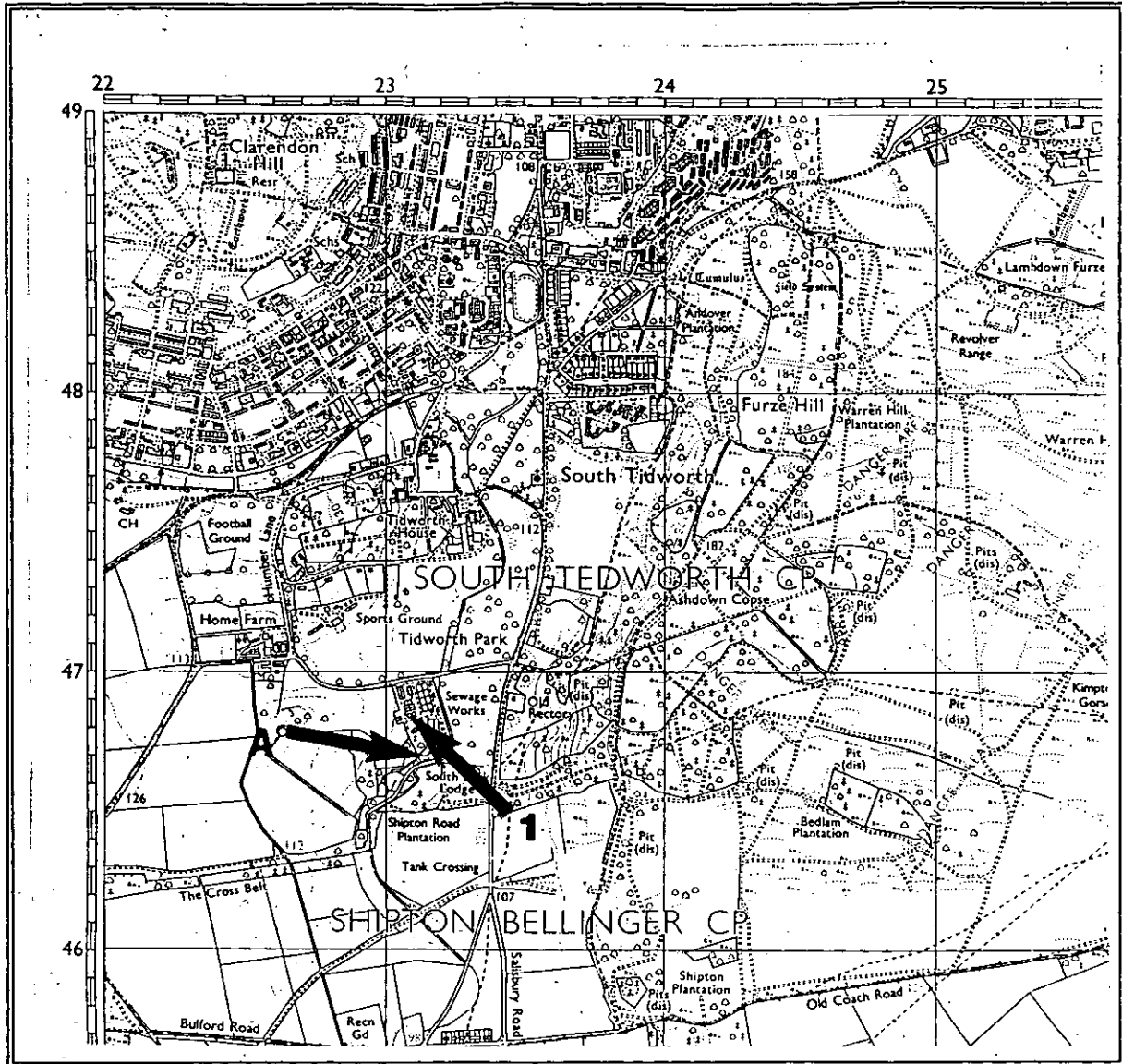

CONSENT CONDITIONS CONTINUED

10. The discharge shall not contain oils or grease in sufficient quantity to produce a visible film on the surface of a sample taken at the sampling chamber.
11. The discharger shall regularly inspect the treatment works to ensure that the mechanical, electrical and other parts of the plant are operating correctly.
12. The works shall be regularly maintained and any defective parts replaced to ensure that the plant operates effectively.
13. Any breakdown shall be attended to immediately and the treatment works returned to operation promptly.
14. The discharger shall keep a record of maintenance and repair for inspection by the Authority's officers.
15. As far as reasonably practicable, the works shall be operated so as to prevent the discharge from having any other adverse environmental impact.

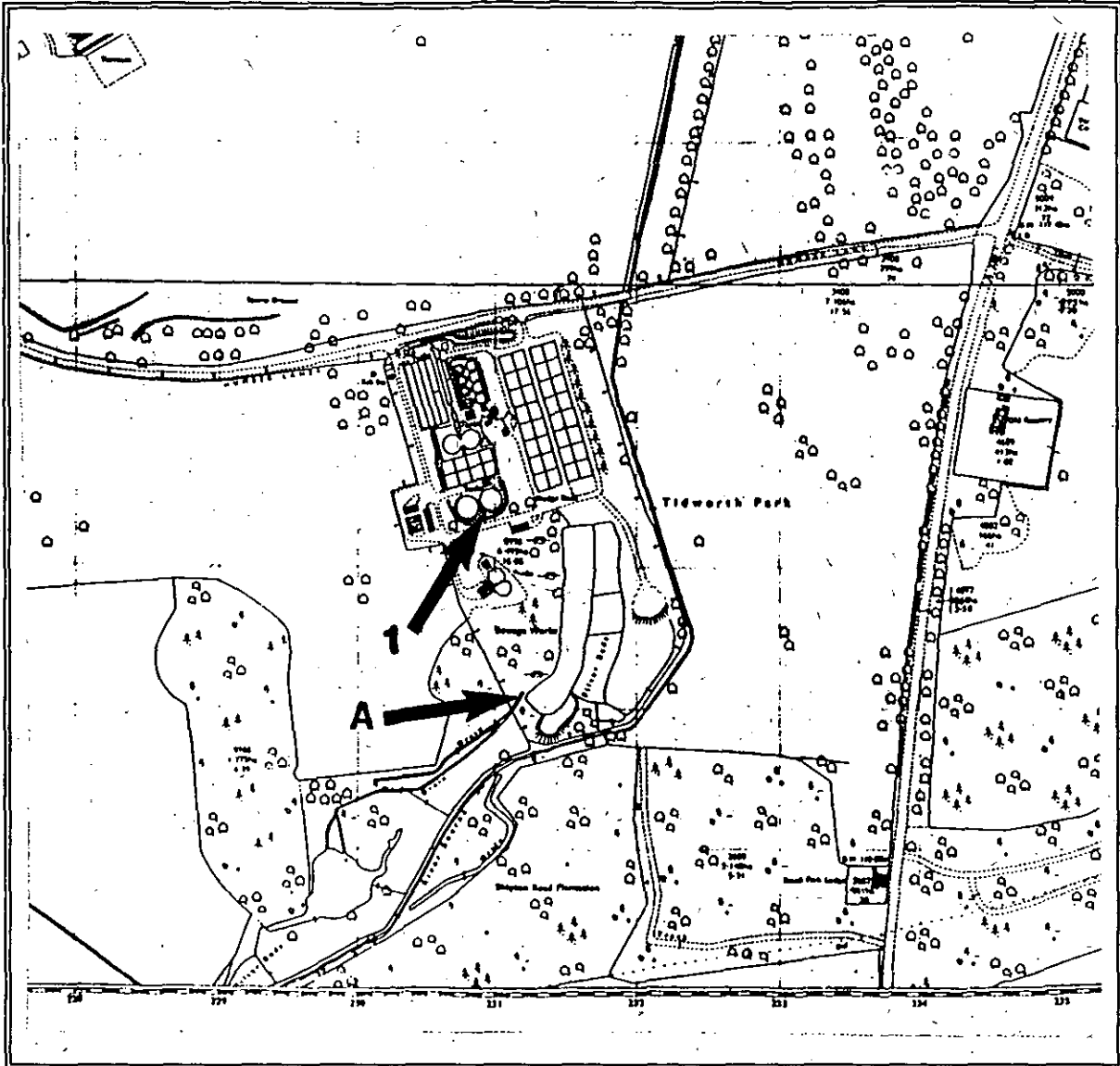

CONSENT NOTES

The consent notes below are provided for explanation and clarification - they do not form conditions of the consent.

- A. If you are not satisfied with the terms of this consent, you may appeal to the Secretary of State for the Environment (Planning Inspectorate). Any such appeal has to be made within three months of the issue of the consent.
- B. This consent includes a copy of a map showing the location of the site to which this consent relates and a plan of the site to assist in interpretation of the consent. The outlets and sampling points are referred to in the text.
- C. The conditions attached to this consent remain in force unless varied as a result of appeal or review. They are binding, not only on the person, company or body named in the consent, but on any person making the discharge.
- D. Notice is hereby given under Section 202(2) of the Water Resources Act, 1991, that the Authority requires to be notified in writing of any change in the particulars of the name or address of the person to whom this consent is given, or who makes or proposes to make any discharge to which it applies, within one month of the change taking effect.
- E. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 169(1), Notice is hereby given under Schedule 20 Water Resources Act, 1991, that a person designated in writing by the Authority may enter premises to which it applies in order to carry out such inspections and take away samples of water or effluent as the Authority consider appropriate.

With reference to the discharge from the above site, please note that we have been informed by the previous owner that you are now the holder of the consent and the responsibility for this discharge transferred to you on 1 September 1998.

The Consent to Discharge should have been passed to you by the previous holder. It should be kept in a safe place, preferably with the deeds of the property and transferred to any future owner of the property.

The consent holder is the person responsible for the discharge and they are required to inform the Agency if responsibility for the discharge is transferred. Transfer of the consent should be carried out using the blue and white Consent to Discharge Certificate of Holder form, enclosed with this letter. If the Agency is not notified of the new holder within 21 days of the change of responsibility, the consent will lapse. This may incur a new application fee in order to reinstate the consent. In the meantime, any discharge made without a Consent to Discharge would be illegal.

It is important to notify us, if the discharge you are now responsible for, has altered in any way from the previous holder's use of the site.

Contravention of the conditions or terms laid down in the consent may constitute an offence under the above Act.

Continued/....

The cost of determining, issuing and monitoring compliance with discharge consents was formerly funded out of the Environmental Service Charge levied on all ratepayers by the water authorities. These charges have now been terminated and have been replaced by a new charge which commenced in July 1991.

An annual charge is now levied on persons or bodies making discharges directly to the water environment. This is similar to the longstanding scheme where all people making water abstractions pay an annual charge.

I am able to inform you that there will be a charge for the discharge of effluent as listed and authorised by these consents and a member of our Finance Department will be contacting you shortly to outline the basis for the annual charge.


