in respect of lands (hereinafter called 'the site')

at 10 Burnt Mill
Elizabeth Way
Harlow.

in the District of Harlow

by deleting the current Conditions 2.0 and 2.1 and inserting the following Conditions with immediate effect:-

2.0 The types of controlled waste received at this site shall be restricted to those detailed in the attached schedules (Annex 1 and Annex Z).

No special waste other than the contents of motor vehicle batteries shall be deposited at the site.

2.1 The amounts of waste deposited each year shall be less than 25000 tonnes.

2.2 No putrescible waste shall be deposited at the site.

2.3 No clinical waste shall be deposited at the site.

2.4 No asbestos shall be deposited at the site.

- 5.14 No waste, except for that detailed in Annex Z shall be deposited on the ground.
- 5.15 If waste not authorised by this licence is deposited at the site the Environment Agency shall be notified immediately. The unauthorised waste should be segregated, marked and removed to a suitably licensed disposal site by the end of the following full working day.
- 5.16 The transfer operation shall be carried out in a clean and efficient manner and not less frequently than once each day any loose waste which may be lying on the site shall be collected and disposed of in such a way as to keep the site tidy.
- 5.17 Waste shall not remain on the site other than with the express written permission of the Environment agency for periods in excess of the following:
- Biodegradable wastes 1 working day
Inert wastes 28 days
- 5.18 Precautions shall be taken to prevent the breeding and harbouring of insects and vermin on the site and immediate steps shall be taken to secure the destruction of any discovered.

ANNEX 1

CATEGORY A - INERT AND RELATIVELY BIOLOGICALLY STABLE WASTES

Solid materials which either do not degrade or degrade only very slowly. They consist of uncontaminated materials from the following list which are not mixed with wastes from prohibited categories:-

- Brickwork and Mortar
- Clay/Soil
- Concrete (reacted) including steel reinforcement
- Excavated Road Metal (Road Planings)
- Flint and Stone
- Glass, Pottery, China, Enamels, Ceramics, Mica and Abrasives
- Gravel/Silt
- Naturally occurring rocks and soils (excluding asbestos and radioactive sources)
- Sand (Including Foundry Sand)/Silica

**CATEGORY B - COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL WASTES EXCLUDING
HAZARDOUS OR HIGHLY POLLUTING SUBSTANCES**

Solid materials which may degrade slowly and generate landfill gas which have the potential to threaten persons and/or property and/or generate leachates which have the potential to pollute ground and surface waters. They consist of uncontaminated materials from the following list which are not mixed with wastes from prohibited categories:-

- Ash and clinker (not including incinerator residues, Pulverised Fuel Ash or ashes containing Vanadium)
- Boiler Scale
- Cardboard and Fibreboard
- Cement (unreacted)
- Domestic appliances
- Electrical cable and wire
- Empty used containers decontaminated and not exceeding 25 litres in capacity
- Excavation and demolition wastes (with a pH in the range between 5-9 inclusive)
- Leather
- Natural and man-made fibres (excluding rubber and vehicle tyres)
- Metals
- Paper
- Plastics
- Plasterboard
- Tar, pitch and bitumen wastes in solidified form
- Trees, Bushes, Weeds and Grass
- Wood and wood products
