Hampshire County Council on 16th February 1995 granted to you a Waste Disposal Licence No. 3/8d relating to the Transfer Station incorporating Soil Screening Plant at Hollybush Lane, Aldershot subject to the conditions set out therein.

The Environment Agency and you entered into an agreement dated 4th September 1998 to make adequate financial provisions in respect of the modifications of such Licence.

THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY HEREBY GIVES YOU NOTICE of modifying the said conditions as shown below:

Delete Condition 2

Insert new Condition 2:

The financial provision for meeting the obligations under this licence set out in the Agreement made between the licence holder and the Agency dated 4th September 1998 shall be maintained by the licence holder throughout the subsistence of this licence and the licence holder shall produce evidence of such provision whenever required by the Agency.

The modification shall not come into effect until seven working days after the receipt of this notice.

The Environment Agency considers that it is necessary for the purposes of preventing or minimising pollution of the environment or harm to human health that Section 43(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 shall not apply in respect of this modification notice.

**RIGHTS OF APPEAL UNDER SECTION 43
OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990**

If the licence holder is aggrieved by the decision of the Environment Agency in modifying the conditions of a Waste Management Licence, he may appeal to the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 43 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, Section 114 of the Environment Act 1995 and Regulations 6 and 7 of the Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994. Appeals must be notified within six months of the date of this Notice to the Secretary, c/o The Planning Inspectorate, Room 10/13, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DN. The Secretary of State has the power to allow a longer period for the giving of notice of an appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of an appeal.
