The following notice, which is issued pursuant to regulation 20 and Part 1 of Schedule 5 of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations S.I.2007 No. 3538 (the Regulations), gives notice of the variation of an environmental permit to operate a regulated facility.

Schedule 2 – conditions to be amended

2a. Condition 3.1.1 is amended as follows:

3.1.1 There shall be no point source emissions to water, air or land except from the source and emission point listed in Schedule 4, Table S4.1.

2b. Table 2.1 is amended as follows:

2c. Conditions 2.3.1 and 2.3.2 are added as follows:

2.3 Improvement programme

- 2.3.1 The operator shall complete the improvements specified in Schedule 2, Table S2.2 by the date specified in that table unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Agency
- 2.3.2 Except in the case of an improvement which consists only of a submission to the Agency, the operator shall notify the Agency within 14 days of completion of each improvement.

IC2	<p>The operator shall submit a revised accident management plan to the Agency for approval.
