I have started to fill in the attached surrender document. There are a couple of sections that require your input. We have previously discussed this site and I recall you telling me it was well run. The impact of organic acids at BH 1101 is suggested to be historic contamination as is the impact of boron at BH1104. It is reasonable to assume the impact of boron is historic if boron was not used during the permit lifetime as stated. The organic acid impact is harder to accept as the concentrations found at surrender at 2 orders of magnitude higher than the concentrations measured during baseline monitoring for permit application. However I will accept this as historic contamination upon your recommendation of acitivities on site during the lifetime of the permit being surrendered.
