WHEREAS Hampshire County Council on 14th February 1991 granted a Waste Disposal Licence No. 3/8a, modified as 3/8c on 16th July 1992 (which on 1st May 1994 became a Waste Management Licence) and was further modified as 3/8d on 16th February 1995, 7th September 1998 and 20th November 1998 to Chambers Waste Management Plc of Chambers House, Jacobs Well, Guildford GU4 7NZ relating to the Waste Transfer Station incorporating Soil Screening plant at Hollybush Lane Aldershot subject to the conditions set out therein.

AND WHEREAS on 17th July 2000 you applied to the Environment Agency to modify the said conditions.

NOW THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY HEREBY GIVES YOU NOTICE of modifying the said Conditions as shown below.

DELETE conditions 18 and 19.

A statement of the Applicant's Right of Appeal under Section 43 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 is set out overleaf.



RIGHTS OF APPEAL.

Section 43(1) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 provides that:

Where, except in pursuance of a direction given by the Secretary of State,

- (a) an application for a licence or a modification of the conditions to the licence is rejected
- (b) a licence is granted subject to conditions,

the applicant may appeal from the decision to the Secretary of State

Therefore if you feel aggrieved by the decision or any of the conditions to the licence as granted you may obtain the appropriate form on which to give written notice of an appeal from:-

This notice of appeal should be accompanied by the following information: a copy of the licence; a copy of any correspondence relevant to the appeal; a copy of any other document relevant to the appeal including, in particular, any relevant consent, determination, notice, planning permission, established use certificate or certificate of lawful use or development; and a statement indicating whether you wish the appeal to be in the form of a hearing or on the basis of written representations. You are also required to serve a copy of your notice of appeal, together with copies of any the above documents that have accompanied your notice of appeal, on the Environment Agency, Swift House, Frimley Business Park, Camberley, Surrey, GU16 5SQ. You should appeal within 6 months of the date that this notice takes effect but the Secretary of State may allow notice of appeal to be given after the expiry of this time period.
