NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF WASTE MANAGEMENT LICENCE CONDITIONS

Hampshire County Council on 16th February 1995 granted to you a Waste Management Licence No. 3/8d relating to the Transfer Station incorporating Soil Screening Plant at Hollybush Lane, Aldershot subject to the conditions set out therein.

THE ENVIRONMENT AGENCY HEREBY GIVES YOU NOTICE of modifying the said conditions as shown below:

Condition 4

Delete whole condition.

Substitute - "No waste management operations shall be authorised by this licence unless specified in and undertaken in accordance with the working plan".

Condition 5

Delete whole condition.

Substitute - "The licence holder shall give the Agency prior notice in writing of any proposed changes to the working plan.

The written notice shall be supported by a written risk assessment of the effect of implementing the proposed change of the working plan on the risk of the site to land, to groundwater, to surface water and to humans dwelling or working in the vicinity of the site.

Any proposed changes to the working plan shall not be implemented unless the Agency has given its written consent to it. Following consent, the licence holder shall give the Agency prior written notification of the implementation date of the change, and from that date the changed section shall be deemed to be incorporated in the working plan in replacement of the previous version of that section".

Condition 38

Delete whole condition.

Substitute - "The method, operation and location of the soil screening plant shall be as described in Section 7 of the working plan and carried out on a concreted surface".

Condition 39

Delete whole condition.

Substitute - "Measures shall be implemented and maintained through out the operational life of the site, in accordance with this condition and Section 12 of the working plan, to prevent and minimise the release of airborne dusts and particulates arising from the site".

The modifications shall take effect immediately.

A statement of the Applicant's Right of Appeal under Section 43 of the Environment Protection Act 1990 is set out overleaf.

**RIGHTS OF APPEAL UNDER SECTION 43
OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990**

If the licence holder is aggrieved by the decision of the Environment Agency in modifying the conditions of a Waste Management Licence, he may appeal to the Secretary of State in accordance with Section 43 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, Section 114 of the Environment Act 1995 and Regulations 6 and 7 of the Waste Management Licensing Regulations 1994. Appeals must be notified within six months of the date of this Notice to the Secretary, c/o The Planning Inspectorate, Room 10/13, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DN. The Secretary of State has the power to allow a longer period for the giving of notice of an appeal but he will not normally be prepared to exercise this power unless there are special circumstances which excuse the delay in giving notice of an appeal.
